

# EMERGENCY PROCEDURE FOR A CHEMICAL SPILL



1. Contact Marina Adelaide's on duty officer on 8169 0000
2. Ascertain type of spill ie diesel, petrol, oil or other.
3. If spill is petrol or similar explosive material, clear area of any unnecessary persons.
4. Ascertain source of spill and stop further spillage if possible ie turn off pumps, release fuel filter caps to relieve pressure in fuel tanks, collect material still flowing using rags or bucket etc.
5. For heavy spills attempt to contain by using Boom and Pads from spill kit on the marina near gangway B or near the fuel wharf.
6. In case of EXTREMELY HEAVY SPILLS eg several hundred of litres which you are unable to control, contact Transport SA (Spills Section) and the EPA (Oil spill) 1800 623 445 on 8248 3505 Radio Channel 12 (24 hours.). Report:
  - Your contact details
  - When & where spill occurred
  - Type of substance discharged & extent of pollution spilt
  - Name of vessel
  - Any other relevant information
7. Dispose of contaminated materials in appropriate receptacles.
8. Monitor until situation is resolved.
9. Establish extent of damage, relevant CLEAN UP PLAN and strategy to make good.
